Telephone to Intercom Interface

Use a Cordless Phone to Manage Drive-up Lanes

Pharmacists and bank tellers can use a cordless telephone to answer drive-up lane calls with the Audio Authority® Model 1533 Telephone/Intercom Interface. A cordless phone, with the addition of a headset, allows the user to roam away from the drive-up window, and communicate hands free with customers. Normal telephone calls may be dialed or received from the same telephone, increasing productivity, saving space, and reducing equipment cost. Use the 1533 along side traditional intercom Counter Stations, or use phones as the sole interface for drive-up lanes. Audio Authority can help design your system to fit your needs.

Features:

- Allows access to any lane via a standard cordless or corded telephone
- Rings the cordless phone when the call button is pressed in a drive-up lane
- Rings the telephone for inbound calls on the telephone line; dial 9 for outbound calls
- Enables call waiting and caller ID for intercom and telephone calls
- Video can be added to the system by installing a one way or two-way video interface (Model 1504)
- May be programmed to perform special functions for off-site operation

Example System:

This application allows a bank teller, pharmacist, or manager to use a cordless phone with a headset as a supplement to the Counter Station. The user may travel within the range of a cordless phone while monitoring or serving customers in the drive-up lane.
